Vicar's February jottings

One of our Values as a Church is *Biblical Learning that equips all ages for everyday living*; I wonder how many of us actually read the Bible regularly for ourselves? With the birth of our grandson I've become very aware of the connection for a baby between weight and regular feeding! As I've said before, getting spiritual nourishment only from Sunday sermons is the equivalent of trying to survive on one meal a week!

If you missed the mouth-watering summary of the Old Testament that David Gale did in just over an hour, the good news is that you can download it through our website or get someone else to download it for you. If that doesn't whet your appetite enough, here comes a special Lenten feast from the New Testament!

The Bible Society is offering us a scheme called "You've got the time". It's open to everybody of all ages in the church & I hope that most will grab the chance. The idea is that we each give up something in Lent in order to release 28 minutes a day. That's all it takes over 40 days to listen to the whole New Testament on a specially provided *BibleStick*:- a dedicated audio player, that comes complete & ready to use.



The process looks like this:

- i. Fill in a card available from church saying which version you'd like to listen to
- ii. Hand in your card at Church by the end of Sunday 15th February
- iii. On Sunday 22nd February your BibleStick will be available to pick up
- iv. From Ash Wednesday and through Lent you take about half-an-hour each day to listen in stages right through the New Testament
- v. There will be sermons based upon what we've listened to and Homegroups will also discuss what we've heard – do ask if you'd like to join in one of these.
- vi. On Easter Day we'll take an offering for the Bible Society that goes towards enabling another church somewhere in the world to listen to the New Testament as we have. The BibleSticks are ours to keep (and share).

If you want to know more, please listen out over the next few weeks and do ask if anything is not clear. God's word never goes out without achieving something significant so I am excited by what will happen as we all take up this challenge...!
