Vicar's June Jottings

There were only about a dozen of us at the Evening Hour on May 21st. At the end we received a prophetic, and passionate tongue. Several people shared their impressions of what God was saying and what follows is a summary of these. Please read this, reflect and respond...

God was pleading with sadness and longing, reminding us that he sent his Son and that Jesus came willingly to live, die, rise and ascend for us. Now in the place of power he is praying for us. God longs for us to come to receive his Son given for us and for the world.

Why do we, his people, not come to hear his word and the wonderful message of salvation? If we in the church don't come to hear his word then how will those outside the church hear the message? If we are not passionate to receive can we be passionate to give? If we are passionate to come that passion will overflow to others.

They are lost and will spend eternity without God, under his judgement and wrath. When Jesus returns He will raise us up and gather us to live with Him. Joy and hope are ours. God bids us to weep and prostrate ourselves before him for others outside the church. God is love. He is irresistible and invincible.

Amos 8:11 [amplified] *"Behold the days come, says the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but a Famine for hearing the words of the Lord."*. A famine brings starvation so if we do not really hear God's words and take them into ourselves then we starve spiritually. So how can we help feed others?
